

Blue Lake Fine Arts Camp Scholarship Day Check List & Info



- Visit **BLUE LAKE ACCESS** at bluelake.org for information, resources, and forms you'll need prior to our visit.
- Inform all arts departments in your school: drama, art, choir, orchestra, band, etc.
- Announce and post audition information for students.
- Inform parents/guardians prior to audition day.

Camp and Scholarship Applications

The Blue Lake scholarship representative will bring camp brochures and scholarship applications for your students. However, your students can get a head start on the process by visiting bluelake.org. The BLUE LAKE ACCESS page is specifically designed for Scholarship Hosts and contains everything you might need to make your Blue Lake Scholarship Day as successful as possible.

Presentation

Blue Lake's presentation offers a brief glimpse of Blue Lake, its philosophy, programs, activities, and camp life. If possible, please allow approximately 10-15 minutes for the presentation and a few questions. When feasible, combine groups and/or departments in order to use time efficiently.

Merit Scholarship Auditions

Blue Lake's scholarship auditions provide young artists with the opportunity to attend camp with a reduced fee. Audition requirements are:

<u>Instrumentalists:</u>	two scales and an excerpt of a prepared piece (Guitar, Soprano Sax not eligible for auditions)
<u>Vocalists:</u>	several vocal warm-ups and an excerpt of a prepared piece
<u>Theater Students:</u>	a one-minute monologue from standard theatrical repertoire; and a musical excerpt if auditioning for Musical Theater.
<u>Art Students:</u>	a small portfolio of work representing a variety of media -photos acceptable
<u>Dancers:</u>	contact Blue Lake <u>directly</u> for dance audition info: 800-221-3796 or visit bluelake.org/scholarships

Financial Need Scholarships

Blue Lake also offers additional scholarship assistance to students whose family income may otherwise prevent participation in camp programs. Financial Need Scholarships are awarded based on audition and financial statement. This special application is available at bluelake.org within the BLUE LAKE ACCESS section for scholarship hosts. Your Blue Lake representative will also have forms.

Student Notification and Registering for Camp

Students will receive notice of the results of their audition within three weeks. Scholarships are valid only for the upcoming camp season, and are not transferable. Scholarships awarded through an audition can take the place of any lesser Blue Lake scholarship already received.

REMEMBER: Students who have auditioned for a scholarship are not automatically registered for camp! Students must submit a completed camp application (located in catalog or on our website: www.bluelake.org) and deposit of \$200 in order to enroll in camp. Students may enroll in camp before applying for a scholarship. Any scholarship received will then be credited to the student's account. We recommend submitting camp applications as soon as possible, as enrollment is available on a first come-first served basis and can fill very quickly.
