To be accepted to the program, students are required to submit a three-minute audio recording (video not required) Two octave major scale of choice, two octave chromatic scale, and two minutes of a solo or etude (3 minutes total).

Top Brass will include eight brass ensembles: Four brass quintets, one trombone choir, one horn choir, one trumpet choir, and one tuba/euphonium ensemble.
